Language:

English language required, excellent level. The two courses can only be taught in English.

Candidate must be fluent in English. He/she must be able to teach the two courses in correct and comprehensible English and must be able to hold a complex conversation with students on academic issues. The result of the Fulbright interview will be of essential importance.

Housing:

Housing is not provided, but assistance in finding suitable accommodation near campus is available. Up to \$3000 is allotted for housing and the reimbursement of research expenses with adequate receipt documentation. Housing costs vary.

Stipend Payment:

The stipend will be paid in installments over the course of the scholar's appointment. The scholar must submit receipt documentation for the available \$3000 in reimbursement funds for housing and/or research. All research purchases must adhere to applicable University research fund policies. The scholar will need to communicate and meet with the Office of Financial and Grant Services in the Humanities Division to complete any necessary paperwork.
